Collaboration and Communication with Patients and Families**

This symposium, including workshops, on communication in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) will take place from 10.00 on November 17th to 16.00 on November 18th at the Faculty of Health Sciences of the University of Tromsø, Norway.

The primary target audience is nurses and doctors who work with the critically ill and their families, both in clinical practice and in research, but others interested in the topic are welcome to participate. Our goal is to improve ICU communication, knowledge and skills.

The faculty includes international capacities such as Dr. Judith Nelson, Dr. Elie Azoulay, Julie Benbenishty, MSc, Dr. Hans-Henrik Bülow and Maureen Ben Nun. All are ICU clinicians and researchers in the field of ICU, communication and ethics. The symposium will consist of key presentations followed by interactive sessions with the audience.

Main focus areas: ICU communication: Theoretical/research background; Effective communication, values and challenges in the ICU; Team collaboration and conflict; Deterioration in the patient's condition: discussing goals of therapy; Communicating palliative care in the ICU; Principles of shared decision-making; Legal and ethical challenges in decision-making: a Nordic perspective

Conference fee: NOK 1000

This includes refreshments and lunch during the symposium for two days.

There will be a dinner at Clarion Hotel The Edge in central Tromsø on 17th November for interested participants.
